

Hillclimbing Returns to Central Washington

2011 Racer X /Malcolm Smith Motorsports NAHA Pro Hillclimb Series Round 1
Sunnyside, WA, April 29-May 1

The only professional motorcycle hillclimb in Washington, the Northwest Nitro Nationals, opened the 2011 hillclimb season, and was also the first round the 2011 Racer X / Malcolm Smith Motorsports North American Hillclimb Association (NAHA) Championship Series. Turnout for a first-year event was excellent, with over 350 entries and 2,100 spectators attending from across the West.

The hill, located 30 miles east of Yakima and 15 miles north of Sunnyside, has a lot of history. First used in 1962, hillclimb events were run on it, off and on, up until 1999. It is a bit remote, but is serviced by two highways, and offers dozens of different competition routes, ranging from 500 to 1,500 feet, and moderate to extremely steep. Many locals were thrilled to see the event return to the region.

Friday's competition included a multitude of trophy and semi-pro classes, and used a 750-foot hill that started with a short, very steep ramp, then rolled out a bit, giving riders time to build up some speed before hitting the last, increasingly steep, 400-foot section. The hills were very green and pretty, but the top layer was dry, which created some dust pockets and ruts and added to the challenge as the day wore on. As expected, few trophy riders were able to get over the hill. Some especially impressive rides included Selah, Washington's Robert Mahre, who almost topped the huge hill on a 125, with a class-winning ride of 724.80 feet, Pasco's Clint Sullivan who jetted over the hill to win the 250 two-stroke class in 23.928 seconds, and Yakima's Shannon Sander who topped the 250 old timer class with an impressive run of 26.212 seconds. Boise, Idaho riders drove six hours to the hill and won several classes with Ken Thornton winning the 17-rider, 450 stock four-stroke, as well as the 450 four-stroke old timer and the senior, 50+ trophy class and his buddy JJ Hill, took the 500 two-stroke division, and Alisha Childs dominated the women's trophy class with a height of nearly 500 feet.

Another noteworthy rider was long-time pro flat tracker, Dan Stanley from Moses Lake, who turned some heads as he won the 0-600 altered class with the fastest time of the day, a very impressive 18.302 seconds, and then for fun, won the semi-pro mini bike class, taking a little 85cc mini up to nearly the 500 foot mark. Kelly Petersen, from Hermiston, Oregon also showed great form as he out climbed a number of experienced guys to win both the 0-700 and 701-up old-timer semi-pro classes.

There also continue to be more women competing in hillclimbing at the semi-pro level. Chelsea Saylor, from Temecula, California, blasted over the hill with a terrific time of 25.450 seconds, and Idaho's Toni Howard also topped the hill with

a time of 32.047 seconds. It is just a matter of time before a talented female hillclimber qualifies for a pro main, and shows a bunch of guys “how it’s done.”

Pro qualifying ran on Saturday on a different, 800-foot hill, and also featured a soft, very steep, initial piece that stopped many in their tracks, at least on their first run. Redding, California’s Austin Fox topped the ultra-competitive 450 pro qualifying with an impressive 18.357 run, with fellow Californian Joe Shipman making a rapid 19.008 pass and Billings, Montana’s Austin Cardwell pulling third with a 19.349. Since only the fastest 15 out of 39 contenders in this class qualified for Sunday’s finals, the action was hot and heavy all morning, and came down to a couple of thousandths of a second for the final spots. The 700 pro qualifying was equally tight, with Montana’s Nick Beer, edging Utah’s Brandon Whitlock and California’s rapidly improving Matthew Garretty, for the top spot. Ageless Canadian, Kenny “Mad Dog” Long, who is now north of 50, also put quite a few “kids” in their place by taking fourth on his new Yamaha nitro 650 twin. Finally, Team Peterson’s Bret Peterson flew his big, nitro KTM over the hill to head the Open class qualifying by nearly a second.

Sunday’s pro mains started out with Harold, “The Gasser” Waddell, from Omaha, Nebraska, edging out Austin Cardwell, Bret Peterson and Travis Whitlock to win the 450 pro class, with new hillclimber Dan Stanley finishing an impressive fifth. Less than half a second separated all five.

The 700 pro class is always thrilling, and it took a perfect run by Utah’s Jason Smith, on his nitro Yamaha, to edge out Waddell’s violently fast, 600cc nitro “Jixer” which is rumored to be producing over 170 horsepower. Only 28 thousandths of a second separated the two, with Austin Fox, Austin Cardwell and Washington’s Ray Babcock rounding out the top five.

The weekend ended with the Open pro final, which featured a unique, four-foot ledge that riders had been eyeing nervously all weekend, wondering which class would have to ride it. As expected, the ledge caused a good deal of grief for some, and produced some impressive endos and tank slappers, much to the delight of the crowd, especially since no one was hurt. In the end, Cascade, Montana’s CR Eisenzimer pulled out a solid win over Waddell, who once again had to settle for second. Utah’s Brandon Whitlock took third, with Matt Coleman and Austin Fox taking fourth and fifth.
